PROPOSED 2019 TOWN OF BYRON TENTATIVE BUDGET:

General Fund Preliminary Budget:

Expenditures:

•A1010.1 (Town Board Services): The Town Board would like to keep at the 2018 rate of \$12,484.

·A1420.4 (Attorney Contractual): The Town Board would like to drop the requested amount of \$12,500 to \$10,000 because Paul Boylan hasn't used close to that amount in the last 2 years.

·A1620.4 (Buildings Contractual): \$38,000 because highway garage needs a new furnace.

·A7110.4B (Parks Committee): Increase of \$5,500 for the tennis court repair.

·A73104 (Youth Program Contractual): The Town Board would like to decrease this amount to \$5,500 and put the extra money in the Town's local recreation program.

A7450.2 (Museum Equip-2019): Why was there \$2,300 budgeted? The Supervisor will speak to the Historical Society President.

A7450.4 (Museum Contractual): The Town Board would like to have the Historical Society President come in to discuss this line item.

A7620.4 (Adult Recreation Contractual): The Town Board would like to hold the 2019 budgeted amount at the 2018 rate of \$5,137.

General Revenue:

·A3005: Mortgage Tax: The Town Board would like to decrease to \$15,000 from \$18,000.

Highway Fund Preliminary Budget:

·Discussion on whether there needs to be a 4th man added to the Highway Department.

DA5110.1 (General Repairs Svc. – Summer Payroll): Increasing from \$65,500 to \$108,300 in anticipation of hiring a fourth man and increase in wages.

DA5110.4 (General Repairs Contractual – Road Work): Decreasing road work from \$160,000 to \$120,000 in order to hire fourth man and balance budget.

DA5142.1 (Snow Removal Town Ser. – Winter Payroll): Increasing from \$127,500 to \$150,000 in anticipation of hiring a fourth man.

·The Town Board decided to come back to the highway budget at the next budget meeting.

Fire District Preliminary Budget:

- The fire companies are each requesting \$120,000 for 2019 due to increasing costs and cancer bill.
- ·They would both like a one year contract, but the Town Board would like to have a three year contract.

•The Town Board will review this matter at the next budget meeting.
