PROPOSED 2017 TOWN OF BYRON TENTATIVE BUDGET:

·The Town Board discussed the Proposed Tentative 2018 Town of Byron Budget. The following comments and inquiries were made:

General Fund/Highway/Sewer Funds Preliminary Budget:

·A1620.4A (Bldg. Contr. – Museum Roof): \$9,200 can be removed because the new roof will be installed in 2017.

·A8160.4 (Refuse Contractual): Contract with Waste Management expires at the end of 2017. The Highway Superintendent spoke with Waste Management and they will extend the contract with an increase after 2 years. The Supervisor will check with the Town Attorney to see if this is legal or if the contract needs to be rebid.

·DA2302 (NYS Snow & Ice): Amount should reflect \$28,000 per contract.

·There was discussion regarding mainline flushing of the sewers. Supervisor Yasses will speak to Shawn from Camden to see what needs to be done and how much it would cost.

·There was discussion about the fund balance and how to increase it.
